Camp Quality Puppet Show SRC Crazy Hair and Sock Day Fundraiser

On Wednesday 10th March we have organised for Camp Quality to visit with their puppet show. It aims to dispel myths and misconceptions that are commonly associated with cancer. The puppets tell an interactive, engaging narrative that explains:

- The ins and outs of cancer
- The importance of recognising our own strengths and the power of positivity
- Why it's important to be supportive of their classmate who is either living with cancer or has a family member with cancer
- That cancer isn't contagious, so it's ok to play


The show helps to reduce the likelihood of bullying, confusion, exclusion, and anxiety that can follow a cancer diagnosis — for children living with cancer this makes the transition from hospital back to school a little less daunting. For children who have a family member with cancer, it helps them relate to their peers who gain an understanding of what their family is going through.

Along with a gold coin donation, students are encouraged to come to school with crazy socks and the wildest, most imaginative hair they can dream of, so get out those teasing combs and hairspray. Please note this is **NOT** a mufti day and students are expected to wear full school uniform.
